




# Swedish Immigrant Trail, GMRPT Legacy, District 4 Chisago County

With great appreciation to the Greater Minnesota Parks and Trails Organization and its members, our local park and trail advocates, the Greater MN Regional Parks and Trails Commission and the Clean Water Land and Legacy Fund, we celebrate another step toward completion of the long awaited Regional Trail. With a grant from the Legacy Fund Section G known as our East End Project is complete.







- At completion the trail will connect the Sunrise Prairie Regional Trail east to Interstate State Park and Taylor's Falls. The trail will connect Taylor's Falls, Shafer, Center City, Lindstrom, Chisago City and Wyoming, also several city parks, schools, libraries and city pedestrian systems within the area. The trail will terminate after traversing through the state's premier Interstate State Park adjacent to the National and Scenic St. Croix River.

- The project includes three bridge crossings over 125' long, enabling connection of a private campground with Taylors Falls, MN, and the Interstate State Park.





- Chisago County will work cooperatively with the State DNR Parks and Trails and each of the Cities along the trail route to make the 20-mile connection east and west across the county. The Swedish Immigrant Trail received regional designation from the GMRPTC in 2014. The project has been awarded Federal Trails Grant funding for land acquisition and Parks and Trails Legacy funding for the recent East End Project.
- Trail users will enjoy an overlook at the Interstate State Park during adventures on the Swedish Immigrant Trail in Chisago County.
