#### GMPT's Legislative Advocacy & Your Role

- At its core, GMPT founded to advocate for the parks and trails of Greater Minnesota
- Legislative Advocacy (AKA lobbying) is a team sport
  - ▶ Lead at legislature is our lobbyist, Elizabeth Wefel
  - Board/Executive Team drives the ship with our legislative policies/agenda as the guide stone
  - Our members play a crucial role as voices to their own legislators and other key legislators

#### Legislative session begins in earnest

- After weeks of chaos, proceedings begin in the House.
  - First day of session, DFL stays home to prevent a quorum
  - GOP continues forward as if nothing happens
  - Supreme Court agrees No Quorum. Standstill
  - Powersharing agreement reached!
- Senate started in a tie and shared power for first few weeks.
  - Election of new senator gives DFL majority
  - Powersharing arrangements gone though glimmers of bipartisanship remain

## Translating the Agenda & Policies into Legislation

- ▶ Bill one: Appropriate 20% of legacy funds to Greater Minnesota Regional Parks and Trails. This bill will also address fees to DNR.
- Bill two: Pay for Commission out of general fund, not legacy.
- Other legislation
  - Support passage of LCCMR bill that include funding for local grants as well as member projects
  - Support inclusion of local parks and trails grants in final bonding bill

#### Progress on legislation

- SF 1039 (Hauschild)/HF 489 (Skraba)
  - Legacy appropriation, extensions, and administrative costs
  - Our bill imposes a flat fee on DNR.
  - First hearing this week in Senate
- SF 1040 (Hauschild)/HF 723 (Skraba)
  - Shifts Commission cost to general fund
  - No hearing yet, but budget requests have not been heard

#### Progress on legislation

- LCCMR Bill SF 506 (Hawj)/HF?
  - Recommendations on how to spend ENRTF
  - Funding for local parks and trails grant programs plus member projects
  - First hearing this week in Senate. Passed to taxes
- Bonding
  - Priority Funding for local parks and trails grant programs
  - Included in governor's bonding proposal, but final inclusion is uncertain

#### Progress on Legislation

- Local Sales Tax Authority S.F. 375
  - Provides expedited process of certain local sales taxes
  - Designated Regional Parks and Trails potentially eligible
  - Discussion continue

#### Other Legislation of Interest

- Outdoor School for All Grant Program Creation S.F. 1050
  - Creates grant program for outdoor education. Must be accredited overnight outdoor school
- Keep It Clean Program S.F. 1297 (Putnam)
  - Surchargeon fishing house licenses
  - ▶ Grant program to local units of government to help keep crap off ice
- Statewide Bicycle Pass Fee H.F. 469 (Heintzman)
  - Creates requirement for a state bicycle pass for all state trails
- No Legacy Funds for Overhead HF 529 (Bliss) /SF 27 (Green)
- Director of Grants Administration HF 754 (Robbins)
